It was reported that this meeting had been arranged with the youth service following the Council 's decision to look into the possibility of continuing the youth service in Llanrug.

Mr Sion Bryn Jones gave a presentation and noted that eight Councils had expressed an interest in continuing to provide a youth club in their area.

The presentation outlined the youth service plan for the future (copy of presentation attached) and following the presentation members had the opportunity to question the officers.

Following the presentation: -

A decision:

- a) continue with the youth club for 2019/2020;
- b) to be held for one night a week with three members of staff;
- c) to be held on Monday evenings (possibly) at The Memorial Institute, Llanrug
- d) The Clerk to inform the service of this decision;

It is noted that one officer has already slotted in, so there will be two members of staff need.

The clerk was also asked to ask officers for the following information;

- a copy of the advert for a job in Llanrug so that I can distribute it in the community;
- a breakdown of costs for 19/20 for one night with 3 member of staff for initially 30 weeks, followed by the rate of reduction every week ie the discount for each week the club;
- information on when the youth clubs are not open (across Gwynedd);
- the age that staff must reach before they can be eligible to work at the youth club.
